OBJECTIVE

In continuity with the JESEDU global meeting in Rio, our purpose is to deepen the way of being Ignatian in a secularised context. Can we find new ways, new words, in order to meet the spiritual needs?

LEADER AND METHOD

Renilde Vos will introduce us to her work with the Spiritual Exercises in an alternative way.

In the past Renilde Vos used to work both as a teacher in religious education and as deputy head of the parish connected to the Catholic University in Leuven (Belgium).

During her work the secularised and pluralistic context she faced called her to focus on the question of how to pass on Catholic faith in a way connected to really lived, existential experience.

Being acquainted with and passionate about the Spiritual Exercises of Ignatius, she found an alternative way to work with these Exercises, following their dynamics but opening up the language to make them better accesible for people coming from different religious backgrounds.

During our conference Renilde will pass on to us some of her programs, focussing on the themes of passion and compassion. Also she will introduce us to her methodology for interreligious dialogue.
